

# 2025 Large Special Events (Projected Attendance: 1,000+)

The Waukegan Park District hosts five large special events throughout the year: Eggstravaganza Trail, American Independence Parade, Touch a Truck/Waukegan National Night Out, Ray Bradbury's Dandelion Wine Arts & Music Festival, and Halloween Trick or Treat Trail. All large special events are free and preregistration is not required to attend.

### Eggstravaganza Trail on Saturday, April 19, 2025

The Waukegan Park District is hosting the 26th Eggstravaganza Trail on Saturday, April 19, 2025 from 9am to 11am at Corrine J. Rose Park, located at 412 S. Lewis Avenue. Children and their families will have the opportunity to hop along the bunny trail and collect eggs from the Easter Bunny and friends, while supplies last. Vendors and free entertainment, including pony rides, a petting zoo, and hands-on bubble stations, are available from 9am to 11am. The bunny trail is open from 10am to 11am.

### American Independence Parade on Sunday, June 29, 2025

The Waukegan Park District will present the American Independence Parade on Sunday, June 29, 2025 beginning at 1pm, and traveling north on Sheridan Road from Franklin Street to Jack Benny Drive. The parade theme and the Grand Marshal are to be determined.
